- Judges must impartially evaluate each dog they judge and award each animal the appropriate placing relative to the event's standard and the competition in the class, regardless of the dog's record, advertisement, friendship, or any other considerations.
- Judges must treat all exhibitors with courtesy, respect, dignity, and impartiality.
